2) Minutes of the 2020 AGM, held on 3 March 2021

The minutes of the 2020 AGM held on 3 March 2021 were approved as a correct record.

Proposed by Nick Bonneywell and seconded by James Robbins.

3) Matters arising, other than those on the agenda

Adam Clarke gave a presentation on a review of the 2020 season and the proposed committee's aims for 2021 including sponsorship and more social events.

4) Hon Secretary's report

The Secretary's report was received and approved as proposed.

5) Accounts for year ended 30 September 2020

The meeting received a summary of the income and expenditure account for the year ended 30 September 2020.

The club had income of £29,701 and expenses of £20,738, leading to a net increase of funds of £8,963.

6) Election of Officers for 2021 season

It was noted that there were a small number of gaps on the notice and those present were requested to think of possible candidates. It was noted that external applicants could be recruited.

The election of officers as per the notice was subsequently approved unanimously by all those present.

7) AOB

The following matters were discussed:

- Sponsorship - Nikhil Patel and Adam Clarke discussed their plans and provided an overview of what would be offered.
- Girls Cricket – the prospect of girls cricket was discussed. It was noted that we had tried to start a section but the key issue was that the local area did not have sufficient demand and there are other established sides in the local area.
- Support measures - it was agreed that the committee would examine support measures available post COVID-19. However, it was noted that our structure within WSC meant that it was difficult to access funding.
- Selection - the selection committee reminded members of the need to inform captains of their

availability on a timely basis each week.

- It was acknowledged that with the impact of the pandemic curtailing activities that it was important to start cricket again. The committee noted this would be as soon as government guidance allowed.
- The meeting also discussed that the club would be getting new kit for the 2021 season with new sponsor. The expectation was that members would purchase kit and train in the new kit, particularly during warm ups.

8) End of meeting

The meeting then closed at 21:05.
